## **FY2018 Continuum of Care Application Available for Review**

**September 13, 2018**

In order to receive the maximum number of points available in Section VII.B.2.d. of the FY2018 Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA), each CoC must have in place a process to make all parts of the CoC Consolidated Application (which includes the CoC Application and the CoC Priority Listing with all project applications accepted and ranked, or rejected and the Project Applications) available on its website, at least 2 days before the application deadline, to its community for inspection and to notify community members and key stakeholders that the CoC Consolidated Application is available.

The FY2018 Northern Panhandle Continuum of Care (NPCoC) Consolidated Application was posted to the website of the NPCoC Collaborative Applicant, the Greater Wheeling Coalition for the Homeless on September 13, 2018. All parts of the FY2018 NPCoC Consolidated Application were submitted in e-snaps on September 13, 2018 in advance of the September 18, 2018 deadline detailed in the NOFA. Project applications included in this submission were: renewal Supportive Services Only, renewal Residential Housing, new Permanent Housing Bonus: Rapid Re-Housing, new Domestic Violence Bonus: Supportive Services Only – Coordinated Entry, and the FY2018 CoC Planning project.
