FY2017 Continuum of Care Application Available for Review

September 25, 2017

In order to receive the maximum number of points available in Section VII.A.2.d. of the FY2017 Continuum of Care Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA), each Continuum of Care must have in place a process to make all parts of the CoC Consolidated Application (which are the CoC Application and CoC Priority Listing) available on its website to its community for inspection and to notify community members and key stakeholders that the CoC Consolidated Application is available.

The FY2017 NPCoC Consolidated Application and FY2017 NPCoC Project List were posted to the website of the Northern Panhandle Continuum of Care Lead Agency, the Greater Wheeling Coalition for the Homeless on September 25, 2017. All parts of the FY2017 NPCoC application, including individual project submissions for renewal of Supportive Services Only and Residential Housing, along with applications for new funding of a Permanent Housing Bonus project to provide Rapid Re-Housing and an NPCoC Planning project, were submitted on eSnaps on September 25, 2017 in advance of the September 28, 2017 deadlines detailed in the NOFA.
